FBO – Grant – School Custodians

Recommendation – Action Item

It is recommended that the State Board of Education authorize the State School Superintendent to award a grant to Local Education Agencies (LEAs) at a cost not to exceed \$8,751,579 in Federal Funds to provide a one-time \$1,000 bonus for school custodians.

In recognition of the increased services and supports required to maintain clean and safe environments for students and staff these grants funds will be used to provide \$1,000 bonuses to school custodians.

Performance Metrics: Metrics of compliance with expenditure requirements will be measured in the Consolidated Application and will be based on the amount of funds budgeted and spent on approved expenditures.

The purpose of this grant is to provide a one-time \$1,000 bonus to custodians no later than September 1, 2023.
